

To assist the successful applicant(s) to travel to a developing country in the Asia-Pacific region for the purposes of undertaking training. The scholarships:

- provide excellent opportunities for trainees to improve skills in open surgery.
- promote a unique perspective on clinical care issues beyond the scope of usual training.
- allow the development of clinical skills in a different manner to that available for the majority of locally based training.
- contribute to RANZCOG's commitment to engaging with the Asia-Pacific region on issues of reproductive health.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- be a FRANZCOG NSW Trainee who occupies a **prospectively approved training position in NSW at the time of application** and has completed a minimum of 138 weeks FTE (three (3) years) of Core Training. **Additionally, applicants need to have sat and passed the FRANZCOG written examination or is an Advanced Trainee at the time of travel.** Applicants must apply for and receive **Prospective Approval of Training from the NSW Regional TAC Chair via the online portal at: <https://logbook.my.ranzcoog.edu.au/>.**
